This year Vermont's Village Building Convergence (VbC) held its fourth annual training focused on building community resilience through workshops that teach sustainable living, practical homesteading skills and community building. This four-day event was held in Central Vermont and featured dozens of workshops as well as keynote by noted author James Howard Kunstler.

Workshop topics include community organizing, permaculture design, natural building, energy descent action plans, asset mapping, and homesteading skills. The gathering, a volunteer-led grassroots initiative, builds community through networking, skill sharing, and increasing interdependence.
